The progress each child has made in our classroom is truly AMAZING! Thank you for being a part of the Pre-Primary 2 classroom!

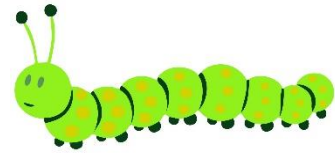
May's Theme: Nature/Spring (butterflies, insects, flowers, reptiles)
